LEAD FORWARD ***Executive Coaching Program*** ***Led by: Neil Sklarew***

LEAD FORWARD is a 12-month peer-based learning program led by an experienced coach that will provide tools and skills necessary for organization and personal development. The primary goal is to develop the executive director's self-knowledge and skills to efficiently work with others around issues of communicating, decision making, managing conflict, managing stress and influencing others.

LEAD FORWARD Program Details:

Start Date: January 16, then other dates TBD by group

Time: 9:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m. plus individual 90—120 minute personally scheduled coaching sessions
(Sessions will alternate monthly between group and individual sessions from January—December)

Cost: \$2,000 up-front [a \$1,000 grant is given back based on participation and completion of program]

Group session topics include: Understanding the Executive Director Linking Pin Role, Understanding How you Use Yourself as an Executive Director, Working with Resistance, Working with Board, Working with Staff

YOU LEAD ***Developing Leaders for the Next Level*** ***Led by: Duane Hinshaw***

YOU LEAD is a 6-month leadership development program for emerging leaders in non-profit organizations. This program provides skill-specific topics that will prepare participants for a greater success in their organization, community and non-profit business.

YOU LEAD Program Details:

Dates: January 29, February 26, March 26, April 30, May 28, June 25

Time: 8:30 a.m.—12:30 p.m.

Cost: \$1,000 up-front [a \$500 grant is given back based on participation and completion of program]

Basic principals include: Leaders Are Learners, Feedback is a Gift, and Lead Self, Lead Others & Be Led
Participants must have permission from their CEO/Executive Director prior to making application.
